Starters

1. **Bor Bia (crispy spring rolls) (V)** £5.95
Crispy spring rolls with shiitake mushroom, carrot, cabbage and glass noodles, served with sweet plum sauce.
2. **Satay Gai (grilled chicken satay)** £5.95
Chicken pieces marinated with spices and herbs on bamboo skewers, served with cucumber relish and peanut sauce.
3. **Ka-nhom Jeep (steamed dumplings)** £5.95
Steamed dumplings stuffed with pork and prawn, served with black vinegar.
4. **Goong Hhom Pha (prawns in blankets)** £6.95
Large king prawns marinated with Thai herbs and wrapped in crispy spring roll pastry, served with sweet chilli sauce.
5. **Tom Yum Goong (hot, spicy and sour soup with prawns)** £6.95
Mushrooms (V) £5.50
A very popular spicy soup in Thailand, made with homemade tom yum paste.
6. **Tom Kha Gai (coconut soup with chicken)** £6.50
Mushrooms (V) £5.50
Chicken (or mushrooms), galangal, lemongrass, kaffir lime, mushroom, onion, spring onion, coriander and tomatoes.

Mains

7. **Gaeng Keaw Whan (green curry) (🌶️)**
Chicken/ Tofu (V) £8.50
Prawns £10.00
8. **Gaeng Dang (red curry) (🌶️)**
Chicken/ Tofu (V) £8.50
Prawns £10.00

9. **Gaeng Pha Gai (jungle curry with chicken) (🌶️🌶️)** £8.95

A spicy chicken curry with homemade paste – made without coconut milk.

10. **Panang Nuer (Thai beef curry) (🌶️)** £10.95

A coconut-based curry with slices of tender beef, red pepper, kaffir lime leaves and sweet basil. This dish is served without much sauce, as is traditional in Thailand.

11. **Pad Phrew Wan Gai (sweet and sour chicken)** £8.95

Stir-fried chicken with sweet peppers, onion, baby sweetcorn and pineapple in a sweet and sour sauce.

12. **Pad Kra Prouw Moo (stir-fried pork with basil)** £8.95

Spicy stir-fried minced pork with green beans, carrots, red chilli, baby sweetcorn, onion and basil, in a spicy chilli and garlic sauce

13. **Suer Roang Hai (crying tiger)** £13.95

Grilled marinated steak served with ground roasted rice, chili and lime sauce.

Noodles

14. **Pad Thai (N)**
Chicken/prawns/tofu (V) £8.50

A popular Thai street food: rice noodles with beansprouts, spring onions and carrots, served with chilli flakes, a lime wedge and ground peanut.

15. **Pad Khee Mao (Thai drunken noodles) (🌶️)**
Chicken/Prawns/Tofu (V) £8.50

Spicy noodles with bamboo shoots, green beans, onions, sweet corn and red pepper, in a chilli and garlic sauce.

16. **Egg-fried rice** £3.50
17. **Coconut rice** £3.50
18. **Steamed jasmine rice** £3.00
